Suggests having a 5 minute turn around between races, unless the Boat Referee is advised of problems. Semaphore are looking for an Open Surf Boat Rower after one of their competitors was coerced into joining a Grange crew. Steve felt this was unfair on his Club as it has disadvantaged their struggling Boat area.

Max Simionate: Questioned re the use of one over age competitor in the Under 21 division, it was explained that this was allowed at the ASRL Open to try and get the Under 21 division going again, but did not apply here.

Questioned if the Beach area at the State titles could be conducted at a separate venue to allow their Under 19 and under 21 crews to compete at State titles. Explained at this stage the event would be conducted at the Middleton State Titles.

Grant Wiles: - Split up of Ina's Western Hotel prize monies, Tony Park advised that would be sorted soon.

David Shaw: - That we should include 160 age group for Women's crews at the Masters State Titles
