**AGENDA ITEMS**

Item 1. Expressions of Interest called for on crews wanting to compete in the Wild Card trials this coming Sunday. Only two crews open womens from Glenelg and Opens Mens from South Port (2nd crew) possible second crew from Grange in mens. Crews advised event would not be held due to insufficient interest. Those wishing to participate in the High Performance carnivals should have their entries into David Earl by October the 16<sup>th</sup>, that's the cut off date.

Item 2. Boat scrutineering, (refer to item in General Business) weights etc Lonsdale shed at 9am on Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> October, Peter Edwards questioned the suitability of doing this so early and what chance did some of the smaller Club's have eg: Whyalla. Discussion re this and decided to go ahead.

Item 3. City of Port Augusta. Nominations should be into State Centre (David Earl) by 1<sup>st</sup> November with cheque for entry made out to Port Augusta Seawater Activities Association. Double points apply for Opens Mens, Open Womens and Reserve grade.

Item 4. Club's wishing to compete in the Western Hotel 180+ series this season must let Tony Park know ASAP so he can get the tee shirts organised.

Item 5. Normanville Short course City of Port Augusta super series start at 3pm on Saturday November 26<sup>th</sup>. Camping available in the basin behind the Club or the Caravan Park. Next day breakfast on at the Club at 7am. Long row from Sunset Cove to Normanville starts at 9am.
