Something we could look at doing here if the numbers don't show up at carnivals to conduct two divisions for Women.

Max Simionate suggested that perhaps the Clubs with Masters Women's crews could liaise with one another and work out which carnivals they will be attending so they can all get to the same event to compete in numbers

Robert Mooney raised the subject of a boat crew that has been at Middleton causing problems with the surfers in the general area. Robert on behalf of the Port Elliot Club wished to express their concerns that this continued action could cause the Alexandrina Council to react in a negative fashion to any future events we wish to conduct in the area. Robert was told the matter was in the process of being investigated by BOSS. The details were handed to the Club President concerned and BOSS will raise at the next meeting for action.

Dick Olesinski. All Boat Captains are requested to make sure they have Port Augusta stickers on their boats

Normanville have shown interest in conducting a Marathon row in December. General feeling of panel was that this is too late in the season for such events. Tony Park to liaise with Bob Menhennett.

Trevor Ferguson requested the Panel look at conducting a similar event to the Ian's Western Hotel 180+ masters for the 140+ Women's' Division. Tony Park indicated this would be looked into.
