

Surf Rowing Youth development 2009 – SA Boat Panel (ASRL SA)

Principles concerned:

1. Eligibility:

Recruitment and/or the presentation of a minimum of one female and/or one male crew per club eligible to compete in any age group from U/19-U/23 by the commencement of season 2009/10.

2. Commitment: Crews concerned have a demonstrable commitment to the program as established by the steering committee.

3. Funding:

3.1. Seek funding support through Rec & Sport/Australian Sports Commission via the SA Branch of the ASRL

3.2. Squad cost/oarsman/woman: personal contribution?

4. Features of program

4.1. Winter Ergos : bi-monthly:

Locations (eg) : July: Somerton

September: Grange

4.2. Ergo content: 1 X 2000m ergo, 1 X 500m ergo and 1 X 10sec ergo

4.3. Winter surf comp: Moana or Middleton dependent on conditions

4.4. Coaching clinics: bi monthly: August, October.

Sunday mornings 9 -12.00noon

Location: Port River out of Port Rowing Club/South Port River Rowing Club

4.5. Interstate competition: Victoria: December 2009: and NSW: January L/WE:
2010 - eligibility for funding

5. Identification: "SA Surf Rowing Development" T shirt

6. Organising group: Chair – Kevin Marks from Brighton to be invited, Secretary – Bill Gaynor.

7. Live in camp: for further investigation.

The SA Branch of the ASRL invites young men and women from South Australian Clubs to register with their Club Boat Captain their interest in being involved as U23 or U19 crews in the 2009/2010 Youth Development Rowing Program.

The ASRL SA requests that all registrations of interest from Club Boat Captains be forwarded by April 30th 2009 to the Secretary of the ASRL SA. A crew may nominate at any stage should the above time frame not suit.
